EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. RSA-005 Series of 2021

REORGANIZING THE MUNICIPAL SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT BOARD

WHEREAS, with the increasing volume of garbage which is posing a threat to the general health and welfare of the public and the integrity of the environment, the national government has employed strategies to combat this pestering problem;

WHEREAS, DILG MC No. 2001-19 mandates all Local Chief Executives to create their respective Solid Waste Management Board in accordance with Republic Act No. 9003 entitled an Act Providing for All Ecological Solid Waste Management Program, Creating the Necessary Institutional Mechanisms and Incentives, Declaring Certain Acts Prohibited and Providing Penalties, Appropriate Funds therefore, and for other purposes;

NOW THEREFORE, I, Atty. Rafael S. Asebias, Municipal Mayor of Quinapondan, Eastern Samar, by virtue of the powers vested in me pursuant to Chapter 3 Art. I, Section 444, par. (iii), of RA 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, do hereby order:

Section 1. Composition. The Municipal Solid Waste Management Board shall be composed of the following:

Section 2. Duties and Functions of the Board. The Municipal Solid Waste Management Board shall have, but not limited to, the following functions and duties:

- (a) Develop the Municipal Waste Management Plan to ensure long term solid waste management as well as integrate the various plans and strategies of component barangays;
- (b) Adopt measures to promote and ensure the viability and effective implementation of solid waste management programs in all component barangays;
- (c) Monitor the implementation of the Municipal Solid Waste Management Plan through the component barangays; and in cooperation with concerned Non-Government Organizations;
- (d) Adopt specific revenue-generating measures to promote the viability of the solid waste management;
- (e) Convene regular meeting for purposes of planning and coordinating the implementation of the solid waste management plans of the component barangays;
- (f) Oversee the implementation of the Solid Waste Management programs, plans and activities;
- (g) Review every two (2) years, or as the need arises, the Municipal Solid Waste Management Plan for purposes of ensuing its sustainability, viability, effectiveness and relevance in relation to local and international development;

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- (h) Develop specific mechanics and guidelines to implement the Municipal Solid Waste Management Plan;
- (i) Recommend to appropriate local government authorities' specific measures or proposals for franchise or built-operate transfer agreements with duly recognize institutions to provide either exclusive or non-exclusive authority for the collection, transfer, storage, processing, recycling or disposal of solid waste;
- (j) Recommend measures and safeguards against pollution and the preservation of the natural ecosystem;
- (k) Coordinate the efforts of the component barangays in the implementation of the Municipal Solid Waste Management Plan; and
- (I) Call on any concerned agency or sector, as it may deem necessary, for support or other appropriate action.

Section 3. Secretariat. The Office of the Municipal Planning and Development of this Local Government Unit shall act as the secretariat which shall handle the administrative and technical activities of the Board. The Secretariat shall also undertake liaising with other administrative levels of the government.

Section 4. Effectivity. This Executive Order shall take effect immediately upon signing.
